WHEREAS, community and commitment to saving healthy or treatable dogs and cats in shelters

results in at least 90% of companion animals that enter shelters, leave shelters to

loving forever or foster homes; and

WHEREAS, adoption provides dogs and cats with a second chance at life and helps reduce the

strain on overcrowded shelters, and promoting pet adoption supports animal welfare

and encourages responsible pet ownership within the community; and

WHEREAS, many loving and healthy animals are waiting for homes in shelters and rescues

throughout Vermont, and many Vermont shelters implement proven programs and

policies to provide alternatives to unnecessary euthanizing; and

WHEREAS, animal shelters can employ lifesaving programs such as foster care networks;

adoption programs; medical and behavioral programs; public education and awareness programs; community cat trap, neuter, vaccinate, and return programs;

and animal socialization programs to prioritize lifesaving.
