FLEECE CAT BLANKETS



MATERIALS FOR FACH BLANKET

Fleece Rotary cutting tool Rotary cutting surface Large ruler

DIRECTIONS


- 1. Place fleece on a rotary cutting surface.
- 2. Pressing firmly with the rotary cutter, cut fleece to approximately 20 inches by 20 inches, or to fit a specific cat bed or area.

Note: Because of the fringe, the finished blanket will be about six inches smaller across than the original piece of fleece. So, you'll want to take that into account when cutting the initial piece.

- 3. Cut a three-inch square from each corner of the fleece (photo 1). Discard the small squares or save them for some other purpose.
- 4. Cut three-inch strips every one-half inch along the edge of the fabric. Continue to cut fringe every one-half inch along each of the four edges (photo 2).

Note: Fringe will be one-half inch wide and about three inches long.







ACTIVITY

To finish off the blanket, tie a knot in each piece of fringe or place two blankets on top of one another and tie the pieces of fringe together (photo 3).
